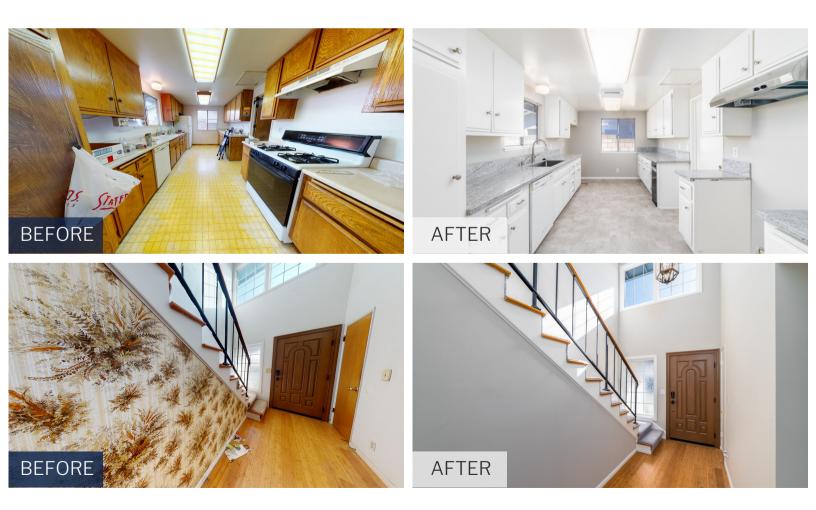
## **Basic Listing Preparation Checklist**

#### Decluttering
